In pursuance of the Notification NO.PIA 57/2017/24, dated 13th November, 2017 by the Governor of Meghalaya envisaging the Scheme relating to engagement of Village Resource Persons (VRPs) under the Meghalaya Community Participation and Public Services Social Audit Act, 2017 (MCP&PSA), **applications in "Standard Form of Application" supported by relevant documents are invited for filling up the post of VRPs in the C&RD Blocks of South West Khasi Hills District as per Vacancies shown below:**

I. Candidates applying for the above posts should fulfil the following conditions:

1. He/ She should have passed the SSLC Examination or its equivalent. Any higher qualification or experience will be an added advantage, especially relating to social audits at the field level or previous work in the MGNREGS, etc.
2. He/ She should be a resident of South West Khasi Hills District.
3. He /She should be in the age group of 18 - 30 years of age (extendable upto 5 years for SC & ST Candidates).
4. He/ She should not be related to PRI representatives, mates and other Officials of implementing agencies.
5. Preference may be given to women candidates.

II. The roles and duties of the VRPs under the MSSAT are as follows:

1. The VRPs will do the document verification and verify all the documents, registers and the scheme file records available at the lowest level of the implementing agency and the document available with the beneficiaries.
2. The VRPs will do the door to door verification of all the Schemes/ Project implemented in the village.
3. The VRPs will verify if the beneficiaries have received their entitlements as per the norms of the schemes.
4. The VRPs will verify whether assets created are as per the norms and estimates of the scheme by doing the worksite visits and taking measurement of works/projects.
5. The VRPs will verify and check the quality of works/projects implemented, samples of materials procured and distributed to the beneficiaries.
6. The VRPs will ensure proactive disclosure of all social audits in a manner easily understandable by the community through presentation of the social audit reports at the social audit Gram Sabha and the Social Audit public hearings.

III. Important notes/information:

- The engagement / appointment of VRPs will be purely on contractual basis for a period of 1 (one) year which may be extended subject to satisfactory performance. The total term shall be of 3(three) years only.
- Selected VRPs will be paid a consolidated pay of ₹.6000/- (Rupees six thousand) only per month and a fixed travel grant of ₹. 1500/- (Rupees one thousand five hundred) only per month will be given. No other allowances are permitted.
- No TA / DA will be admissible to applicants for attending the Written Test / Interview for the above mentioned vacancy / post.
- Candidates applying for the above mentioned vacancy / post of VRPs will have to submit their applications to the Office of their respective Block Development Officers and the last date for submission of the application forms is **8th December, 2017**.
- The date and timing for the selection Test / Interview will be notified at a later stage.
